Owner's great-great-grandfather related stories of visiting the 2-story house

during the Civil War.

According to the BLM patent records, Simon Aitchison [sic] received the patent for the land in June 1860. The Santa Fe Trail was located about a mile to the south (along with some unnamed roads to the immediate east) when the township was surveyed by the GLO in 1856 and would have still been in use in 1860. Atchison sold the property to William Greenfield in 1873 for

\$400.

1960s and 1970 on the east and north sides.
